How to Help Teachers Save Water

- Make posters with water-saving tips for each classroom.
- Remind teachers about simple ways to save water during staff meetings.
- Give awards or certificates to classrooms that save the most water!

How Students Can Help

- Be a "Water Hero" and remind friends to turn taps off.
- Check taps in classrooms and tell someone if they are leaking.
- Do fun experiments to see how much water we can save.

What We Will Do Next

- Make colourful water-saving posters for all classrooms.
- Show teachers simple ways to save water.
- Share our water-saving ideas in a school assembly soon.
