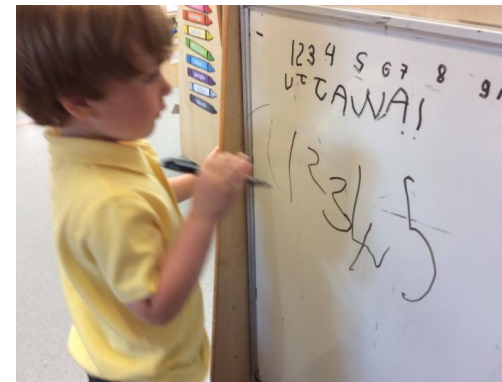


We are Nursery!

Please collect your child from the classroom via the Nursery garden. (Follow the main path into school by the car park).

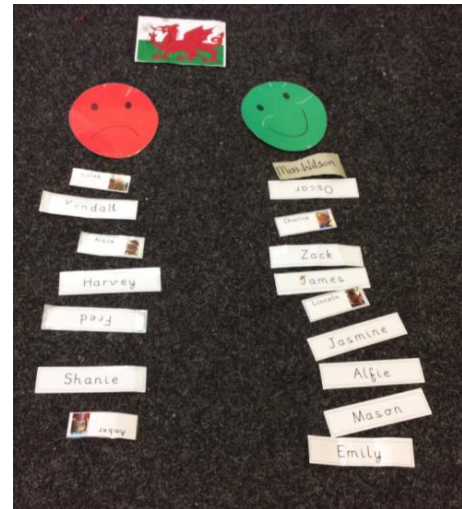

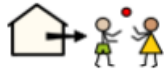

Morning Session

- The Nursery gates will open at 08:45. Please drop off your child in the Nursery garden where the EYFS team will be waiting to greet them.
- The Nursery gates will open for collection at 11:45. Please collect your child from the Nursery garden.

Afternoon Session

- The Nursery gates will open at 12:20. Please drop off your child at the Bungalow gates where a member from the team will be waiting to greet them and will take them along to the Nursery classroom.
- The Nursery gates will open for collection at 3:20pm. Please collect your child from the Nursery garden.
- To safeguard children the Nursery doors will remain open for 5 minutes at drop off and for collection. Please ensure you are on time when dropping your child off and collecting them.

Attendance and the role of parents/carers

Parents/Carers have an essential role in ensuring their child's good attendance.

Regular attendance is critical if our pupils are to be successful and benefit from the opportunities presented to them.

We ask parents/carers to:

- Establish good attendance habits by acting as a role model and showing the children that good attendance and punctuality is important.
- Contact the school by phone, text, email or letter as soon as possible to say why their child is absent, and when they are expected to return.
- Avoid taking holidays in school time.
- Ensure that wherever possible, medical appointments are made outside of the Nursery session.
- Know daily and weekly Nursery routines to avoid issues, e.g. ensuring children have their P.E. kits on the right days.
- Establish a good bedtime routine, so that their child can sleep well, get enough sleep and make mornings less of a struggle.

Personal Independence - September ready!

- Dressing themselves - please support your child to be able to dress and undress themselves (simple clothing, e.g. t-shirts, leggings). Support with putting arms in coats and taking coats off.
- Toileting independence - joggers are best for children who find it tricky to undo buttons/clasps particularly on boys 'uniform trousers'.
- Nursery staff are more than happy to support with toilet training - every nappy change takes an adult away from children's learning and time with your child.
- Velcro shoes - please ensure that your child comes to school in shoes that they can fasten/unfasten themselves.

- We can't wait to meet your child where they are and begin their learning journey!
- Please ensure that your child has a bag to bring to Nursery everyday containing a full set of spare clothes (including underwear and socks), a water bottle and wellies for outdoor play. Please label everything clearly.
